Drug Treatment Method

- 1. Outpatient (mild to moderate dependency)**
 - Counselling
 - Group meeting
 - Family Support Group, etc
- 2. Inpatient (moderate and severe dependency)**
 - Medical intervention (physical and psychiatric intervention)
 - Social Intervention (TC combining with thematic-working group, religi-based treatment)
