Permissive Parenting Style

Then Children

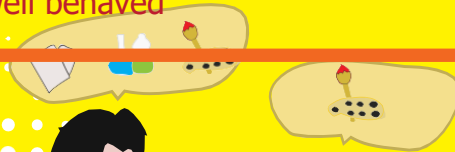
- Being a selfish child

Democratic Parenting Style

If PARENTS

- Applying the rules with clear objectives and communicated to children
- Applying freedom, but there are limits
- Rewarding children with the opinions and thoughts
- Close to the child
- Directing children well behaved

- Confidence
- Believing parents to control themselves
- Independently
- Compromise
